

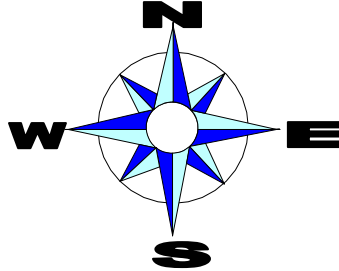

Their influence is felt in all directions

I. LEADING DOWN – Those under our care

A. By EXAMPLE 1 Peter 5:3; 1 Cor. 11:1

B. By ENCOURAGEMENT Heb. 10:24-25

C. By EXERCISING faithful stewardship Titus 1:7

1. A Steward – One ENTRUSTED with the MANAGEMENT
of someone else's affairs.

2. The Requirement: FAITHFULNESS 1 Cor. 4:1-2

3. The Key: DISCOVER WHAT THE OWNER WANTS DONE, and doing it!

4. Faithful Stewards understand four principles:

a.) OWNERSHIP Psalm 24:1 b.) RESPONSIBILITY 1 Cor. 9:17

c.) ACCOUNTABILITY Rom. 14:10-12 d.) REWARD 2 Cor. 5:10

5. The Principle of Responsibility – for elders

a.) Direction: by EXAMPLE 1 Peter 5:3 MANAGING 1 Tim. 3:5

b.) Discipline: PUBLICLY 1 Tim. 2:10 PRIVATELY Gal. 6:1-2

c.) Doctrine: TEACH 1 Tim. 3:2 GUARDING Acts 20:28-31

d.) Development: SPIRITUAL LIFE John 21 SPIRITUAL GIFTS Eph. 4:12-16

II. LEADING UP – Those over us

A. By ENCOURAGEMENT Heb. 10:24-25; 2 Tim. 1:16

B. By PRAYER Col. 4:2-6

C. By CASTING VISION

III. LEADING LATERALLY – Those who are our peers

A. By MUTUAL SERVANTHOOD/SUBMISSION 1 Peter 5:5; Eph. 5:21

B. By WIN-WIN SITUATIONS

C. By PRACTICING a Christ-like attitude Phil. 2:3-4

1. Be SELFLESS - loving unselfishly

2. Be SACRIFICIAL - humble

3. Be SERVING - considerate

David “encouraged himself in the Lord” 1 Sam. 30:6

Hybels: Several self-leadership questions to ask ourselves.

1. Is my CALLING sure? Acts 20:24; Col. 4:17

2. Is my VISION clear? John 17:4

3. Is my PASSION hot? Rom. 9:2-3

4. Am I DEVELOPING my gifts? Eph. 4:11-12

5. Is my CHARACTER clean? Neh. 7:2

6. Is my PRIDE subdued? 1 Pet. 5:3

7. Are my INNER WOUNDS undermining my ministry? Heb. 12:14-15

8. Are my FEARS at bay? Joshua 1:8-9

9. Is my PACE sustainable?

10. Is my LOVE for God and people increasing? Mk. 12:30-31

A leader must learn to lead and influence in all these directions.
